Screenwriter and film director, Marina Spada teaches at the *Civica Scuola del Cinema* in Milan. Among other works, she made the video portrayals of *Fernanda Pivano*, *Gabriele Basilico*, and *Arnaldo Pomodoro*. In 2002, she shot *Forza Cani* (Go Dogs), the first Italian collaboration film on the web.
